Classroom support, small group support or one-on-one support based on needs


EQAO

Our EQAO dates are June 6 – 10 for Grade 3 and Grade 6 students.


The tests are all online this year.

Total test time for all parts is 3 hours 35 minutes, which is a significant reduction from previous test years.


As a default, students in Grade 3 will write their written responses on paper and students in Grade 6 will type their responses in to the test.




PRIMARY LANGUAGE
