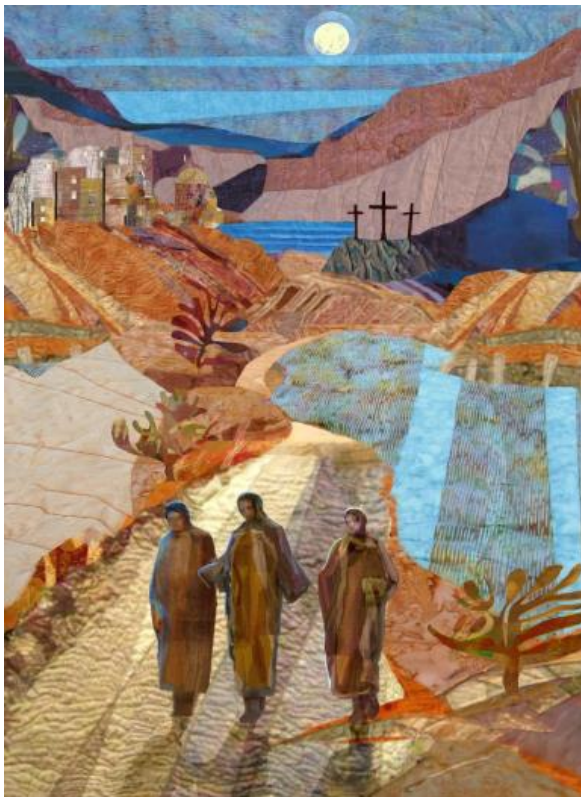

Notes

- \$1 499.00 for spirit wear is revenue. We have not been billed for the spirit wear yet. We anticipate a profit of ~\$400.
- Food/milk #3 is the current food/milk order that goes until March 7. We have not been invoiced for most of this order yet. We anticipate a profit of ~\$600.
- We have ordered a Lenten calendar or magnet for each class. This cost has not been billed yet and is ~\$360.
- This makes the actual account balance ~\$3 775.
- There is \$1 034.45 held in trust at the board office for the sound system purchase.

Upcoming possible expenses from SGF (School Generated Funds)

River Valley Tube Sliding subsidy ~\$5 per student = ~\$1 125

Ticket cost is \$20 per student, subsidy would make it \$15

AM and PM times – 2 classes at a time

Bussing is \$1 855.55

Grant is \$2 000.00

\$5 per student subsidy = \$1 125.00 out of SGF

Graduation ~\$2 200 last year

Sound System = \$2 634.40

SOUND SYSTEM QUOTES

From Alissa's notes: *I chatted with Steve at Long&McQuade and looked at the speaker units last night. The sound is amazing (I only got to hear one speaker at 1/2 volume). He thinks we do not need the mixer and has included one mic in the quote but if the school does not have mics, we could add another.*

We can try out the system, but we would have to rent the system to do so.

The system is Bluetooth, so we can have music playing and two mics going. Speakers are chargeable (so no cords outside, therefore the speakers can "go" anywhere) but can also be plugged in (perfect for indoor). The speakers do have to be linked together by a cord if we want to have two playing together. There are stands included in the quote and the cable, I believe. If we take the mixer board out that is a savings of \$400.

We can rent a mixer board, extra mics and larger speakers in the event we need them for a one time use.
