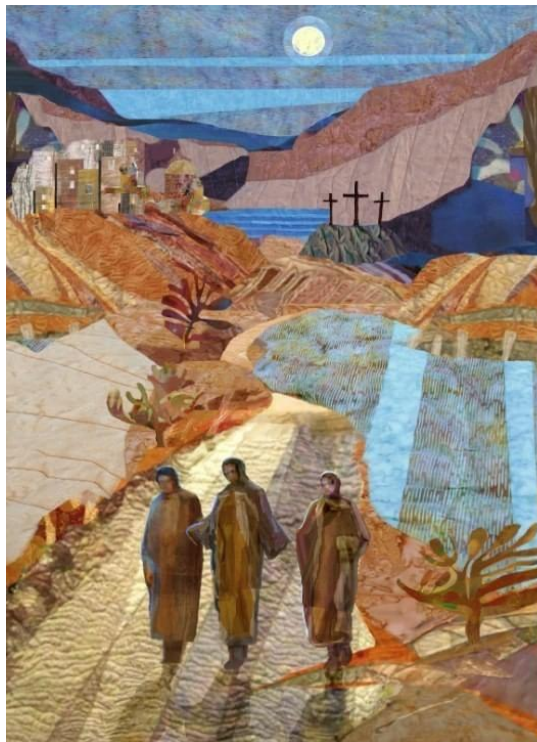

Hot lunches

AO Pasta

- short noodles with tomato sauce and bread , \$5.00 cost to school, charge \$5.50
- short noodles with meat sauce and bread, \$7.00 cost to school, charge \$7.25
- gluten free is \$3 more (Andrea will reach out to 2 families that order gluten free pizza to offer option)

Pita Hut

- Whole wheat pita, choice of 3 meats, multiple veggies/cheese, cost to school \$6.00, charge \$6.25
- This is more expensive than subs

Chicken Nuggets



- Papa John's could be alternate provider. Cost to school is \$3.90, another school charges \$5.25, cardboard container (we can ask for liner or wax paper to be able to recycle, cannot recycle is soiled)
- This is considerably less than New Orleans

Will offer some of some of these new options in rotation with pizza.

- We cannot provide an option to students in JK/SK that includes eggs (severe allergy). Will check with providers. This class may have pizza only as their hot lunch option unless we can find another option or any of these options are egg free. Pizza has been confirmed to be egg free.
- Milk will be back in the next set of food orders as we have a new cooler to keep the milk in.

Portable shelter purchase

- Suggestion for purchase of portable shelter with school logo on it for events (Pat Cook, soccer, cross country, 2-pitch)
- School already has one, no logo
- Tennile will look into cost/pricing for this
- Staff member indicated it would be a big help if a parent/guardian who was at the event could bring the shelter and help set up. Sometimes the one we haven't doesn't get used because there is a lot of other equipment to bring for the event and needing to supervise students.

Swing set

- CSAC wondered about fundraising for a swing set (equipment) for the school yard.
- Andrea will look at safety requirements, possible sources for grant money, and providers to get an idea of what this will entail and the funds that would be required for next meeting
